Focus: And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us. (John 1:14a)

Prayer Points:

- Thank the Lord that He has allowed us to see the beginning of another year.
- Thank Him that He desires for His presence to manifest in every area of our lives.
- Give thanks to God that Jesus is both fully God and fully human.
- He is our Advocate. (1 John 2:1)
- He is the One through whom we have gained favour with the Father. (1 John 2:2)
- He is our great High Priest who sympathises with our weakness and through whom we have bold access to the Throne of Grace. (Hebrews 4:14-16)
- He is One through whom all Spiritual blessings are made available to us. (Ephesians 1:3-14)
- He has gone ahead of us in 2026 so we do not need to fear. (Psalm 27)

SUNDAY 4TH & MONDAY 5TH JANUARY

Focus: We beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. (John 1:14b)

Jesus revealed the Glory of the Godhead - its beauty, its perfection, its majesty, its holiness, its purity....

(John 1:1-5; 1 John 1:1-5; Colossians 1:14-18; Hebrews 1:1-4; Revelation 1:10-18)

Prayer Points:

- Use the above scriptures to just express your worship to Him who deserves all the glory and honour.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to open our eyes as a church that we will behold Him for who He is and know what He has made available to us. (Ephesians 1:17-23)
- Pray for an increased hunger to know Him deeply this year by every individual, every family, every ministry and Connect Group and as an entire congregation.

Focus:

And of His fullness we have all received, grace for grace. (John 1:16)

The truth is that we become whatever we keep beholding. We are shaped by whatever or whoever we spend a lot of our intentional time with.

As Moses spent intentional time in the presence of God He reflected His glory.
Exodus 33:7-34:9

We belong to the New Covenant, and the glory of Christ is what we reflect.
2 Corinthians 3:16-18;

Prayer Points:

- Pray that every veil that prevents us from receiving and revealing His glory will be removed in Jesus Name. Every mindset that hinders us from fully receiving and revealing can be like a stronghold which must come down in Jesus Name. (2 Corinthians 10:3-5)
- Mention the different veils such as:
 - Disappointment
 - Deception
 - Demonic attack
 - Distraction
 - Doubt & unbelief
 - Shame & guilt
 - Others
- Pray for our loved ones by name that every veil Satan has put over their hearts and minds be removed in Jesus Name. (2 Corinthians 4:3-6)
- Pray that as a Church we will manifest the Glory of Christ in our homes; places of work, leisure and study and specifically in Ilford and beyond. (Matthew 5:14-16)
- Pray that we will proclaim the Gospel with boldness with signs and wonders following. (Mark 16:15-20)
